

What to do if.....	Action needed	Return to school when....
My child has <u>coronavirus symptoms</u>	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Update school regularly Self-isolate Get a test Inform school immediately about test result	The test comes back negative and they are fever free within the last 48 hours.
My child has <u>coronavirus symptoms</u> – developed during the school day	Pupil will be moved a safe distance away from others into a well-ventilated area Parent/Carer will be contacted to arrange collection of child Parent/Carer advised to follow PHA guidelines All areas where the individual has been in contact with will be cleaned appropriately Pupil needs to get a test Inform school immediately about test result	The test comes back negative and they are fever free within the last 48 hours.
My child <u>tests positive</u> for coronavirus	Inform the school immediately about the test result DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Update school regularly Self-isolate for at least 10 days	They can return to school after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of taste of smell/taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks once infection is gone. If they continue to have a high temperature they should stay at home.
Somebody in my household has coronavirus <u>symptoms</u>	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL for 14 days Update school regularly Household member to get a test Inform the school immediately about the test result	Stay at home for 14 days after the first person in your home started having symptoms. If the person receives a negative result from a Covid-19 test, child may return to school.
Somebody in my household has <u>tested positive with Coronavirus</u>	Inform the school immediately about the test result DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Update school regularly	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
The Track and Trace scheme has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms of confirmed coronavirus	DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Update school regularly Self-isolate for 14 days Get a test	The child has completed 14 days of self-isolation, or has received a negative result from a Covid-19 test
My child has travelled abroad and has to self-isolate as part of the quarantine process	<u>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed</u> DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Update school regularly Self-isolate for 14 days	When the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed
A Staff member or another pupil in my child's class bubble have tested positive – in the 48hrs preceding symptom onset (or positive test result in an asymptomatic individual)	Inform the school immediately via email or telephone – a text message and email will then be sent to the school community – This will not name the child/staff member. The message will state that pupils and staff members within that class must remain at home until a certain date and online learning will begin. DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL Everyone in the bubble will need to self-isolate and will not come to school. Track and Trace will advise. <i>(Please note – only family members of the positive child self- isolate. Siblings of the class members who are having to remain at home because a child in their class tested positive still attend school – it is only the child in the class bubble that is required to self-isolate)</i> Classroom deep- clean will begin after 72hrs of positive case being identified.	When a negative test is confirmed or the necessary isolation period has been completed.
