

Who are the Family Support Hubs?

- Each Family Support Hub is a group of organisations including community, voluntary and statutory who deliver services to children / young people (0-17 years) and their families.
- There are 4 Family Support Hubs in the Northern area all led by Action For Children.
- Each Hub aims to link you and your family to the right service to meet your needs.
- We will work in partnership with families, listen to your needs and will help you and your family access the support service best suited to you.
- We are unable to accept referrals for any child or young person who has current involvement with either Social Services or Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS) as this is above our early intervention remit.
